A Tip for Yamaha Keyboards (or 'ow its dun)

I have use OTS's for some time now because the support *AUTO FILL IN* when move up or down the OTS settings.

But now I have now discovered that this is possible to do the same with *REGISTRATION MEMORY'S* and even use the *BREAK* function, this can be also used with the foot switch.

So here's how, first set up your Registrations as you wish, with Style, voices, octave, DSP effects, etc, and save them into your registrations, as many as you wish.

Now comes the add *fills or breaks*, simply press the style fill or break button, and whilst this is still running press the *memory button* simultaneously with the Registration button, (number 1-8).

So for example [Reg' 1], style of say (Country Pop), *Press style button A*, as you would for a fill, ensuring required (Auto Fill function is selected i.e. lit up), and whilst the fill/break is playing, press MEMORY and Reg 1 together, now you have an auto fill/break in Reg 1, do this to all other required Registrations and use exactly as with the OTS function, as an added bonus you can use them with a foot switch, with *Registration Sequence*. This allows you to have eight or more voice/style changes using the registration banks.

This sound complicated but its not, all you have to do is ensure that the **MEMORY button**, is pressed at the same time as the **Registration button!** As the **fill/break** is active! Try it, it's easy to do, but hard to describe.

Please Note If **freeze is on** this function will not work.
